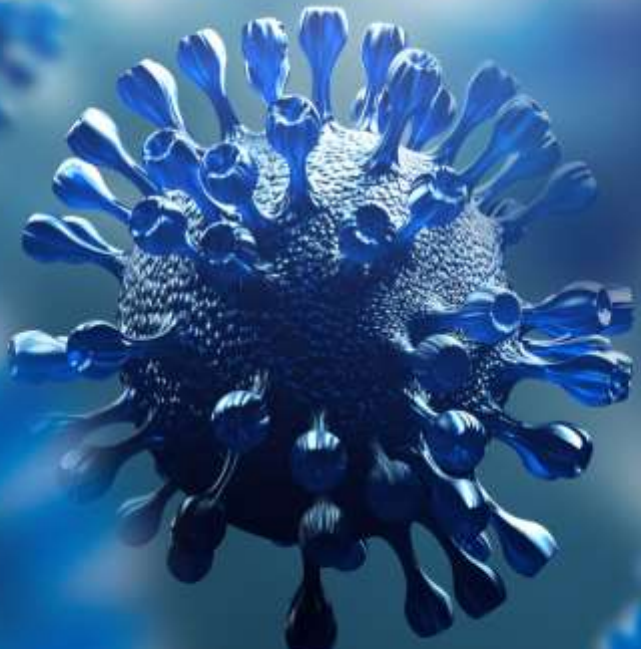

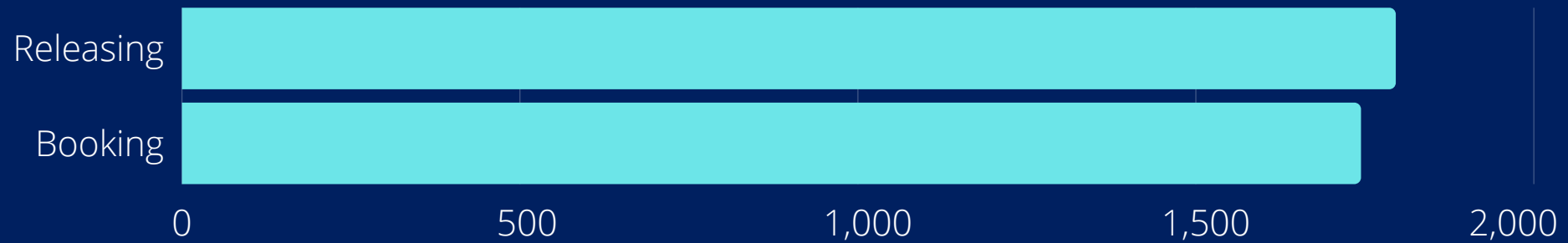

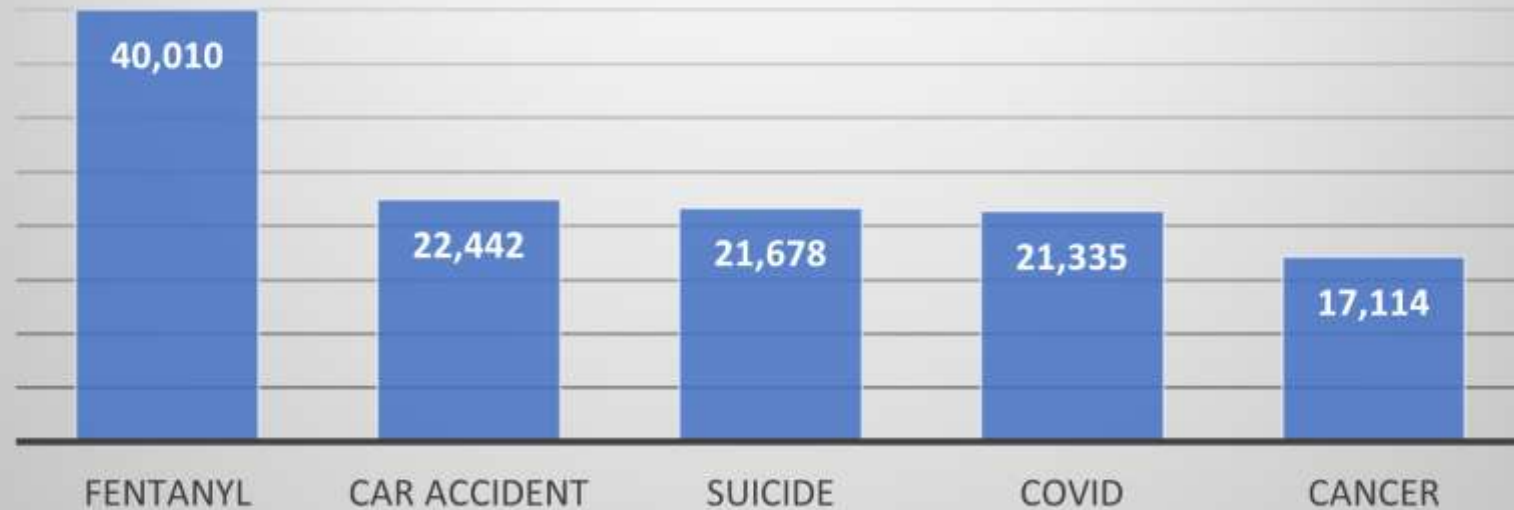

# SEARCHES AT INTAKE

- During Intake, new detainees are strip searched
- Better detection of foreign objects
- Objects like weapons, drugs or other prohibited items



## OCDC SPECIAL INVESTIGATORS STOP FENTANYL SMUGGLING ATTEMPT

- Received a tip of an individual being arrested on purpose to bring in contraband
- Detainee was identified and searched
- Discovered 72 grams of Fentanyl and Marijuana
- Enough to kill every person at the jail



# SEARCHING PODS AND MOVING DETAINEES

- Searching pods and detainees more frequently
- Strip searching and moving detainees when intel shows possible “hot spots” for contraband

# EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL/INCREASE DISCUSSION

- Distribution of educational material to detainees and staff
- Placing of flyers on each floor, in several locations
- Staff leadership contraband training sessions
- Increase level and amount of discussion with detainees and staff

# FENTANYL

## SAFETY RESPONSE FOR DETENTION OFFICERS

### DO:

IMMEDIATELY CONTACT SHIFT SUPERVISOR  
CLEAR EVERYONE FROM THE AREA OR CELL  
IF YOU'VE BEEN EXPOSED IMMEDIATELY  
NOTIFY MEDICAL

### DO NOT:

TOUCH OR DISTURB SUBSTANCE  
ALLOW ANYONE NEAR SUBSTANCE EXCEPT  
TRAINED PERSONNEL/INVESTIGATIONS



### KNOW THE SIGNS OF OVERDOSE

SMALL, CONSTRICTED  
"PINPOINT PUPILS"  
FALLING ASLEEP OR  
LOSING  
CONSCIOUSNESS  
SLOW, WEAK, OR NO  
BREATHING  
CHOKING OR  
GURGLING SOUND  
LIMP BODY  
COLD AND/OR  
CLAMMY SKIN  
DISCOLORED SKIN  
(ESPECIALLY IN LIPS  
AND NAILS)



ANY DRUG MAY CONTAIN  
DEADLY LEVELS OF  
FENTANYL, AND YOU  
WON'T BE ABLE TO SEE IT,  
OR SMELL IT. IT IS NEARLY  
IMPOSSIBLE TO TELL IF  
DRUGS HAVE BEEN  
LACED WITH  
FENTANYL.



# EMPLOYEE AND VENDOR SEARCHES

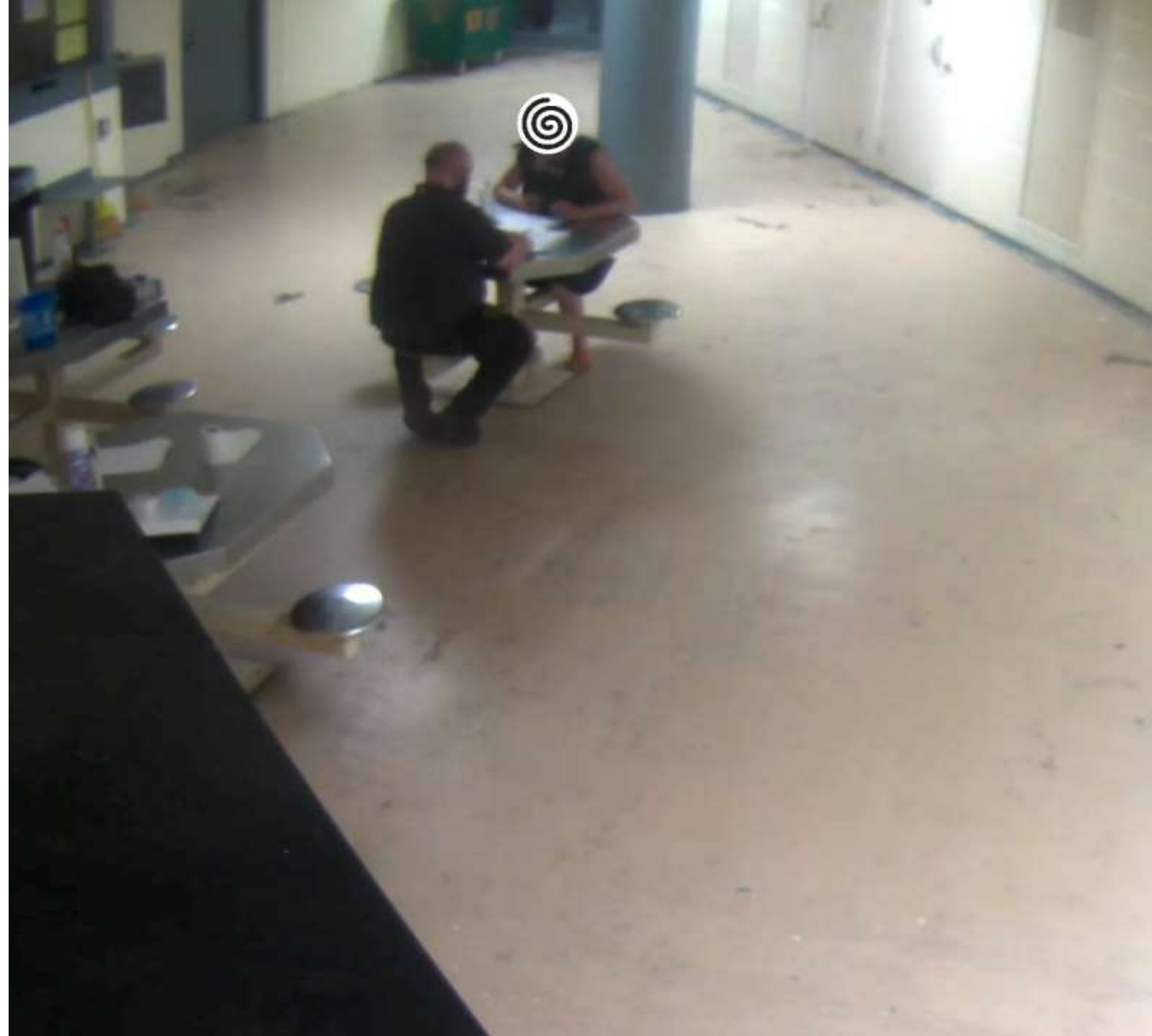
- More frequent searches of employees and vendor staff as they enter facility

## INCREASED COMMUNICATIONS

- Increased communications with detainees to tell staff if someone is in crisis or using/possessing contraband
- Communicating the urgent need and requirement of site checks/welfare checks

## TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT

- Training and equipment in the mailroom to help protect staff and detect contraband
- Extra PPE for investigators and staff working cases when dangerous drugs are suspected



# INVESTIGATION UNIT DRUG TRAINING

- Drug Enforcement Agency training on narcotics identification and new ways contraband is being concealed
- Partnership with DEA/OBNDD on education and investigations

# FUTURE ACTIONS BEING CONSIDERED

OKLAHOMA COUNTY

- Body scanner for intake and transportation
- X-ray machine at employee entrance (incoming boxes, bags and property)
- Off duty law enforcement at entrances for higher security levels
- Via Path Technologies off site mail scanning for incoming detainee letters, cards and pictures
