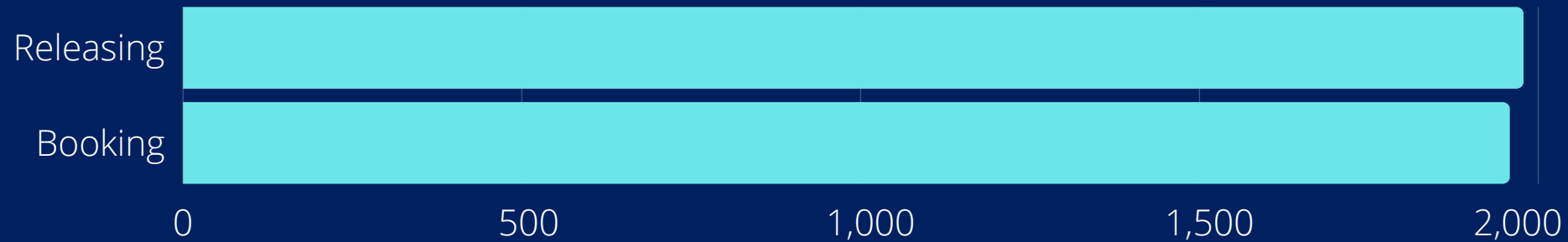

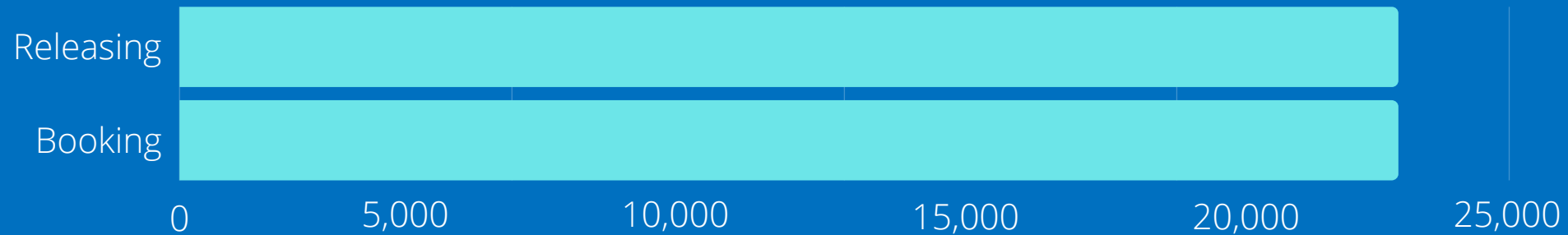

HISTORICAL POPULATION HIGHEST MONTHLY POPULATION EACH YEAR

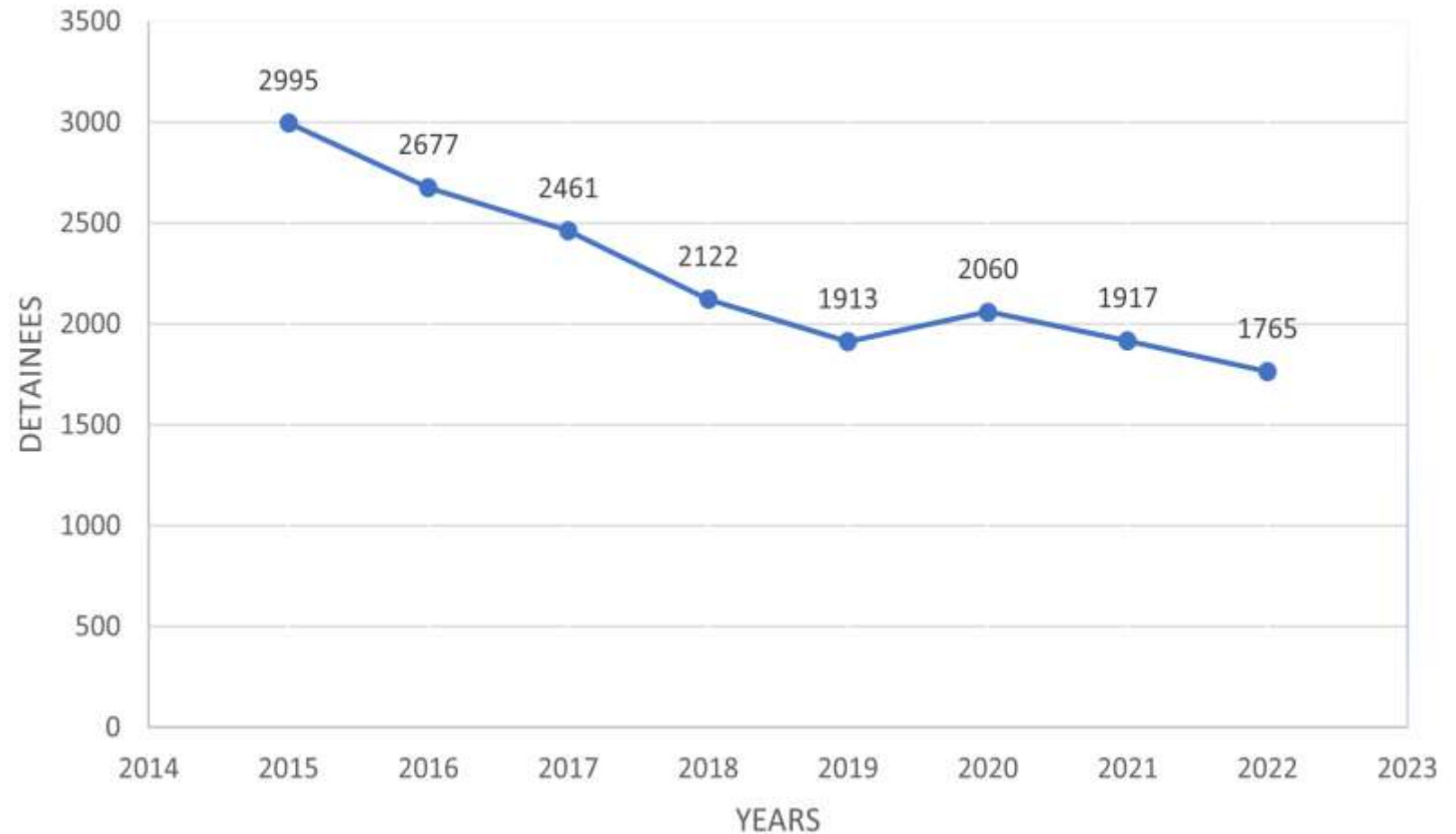

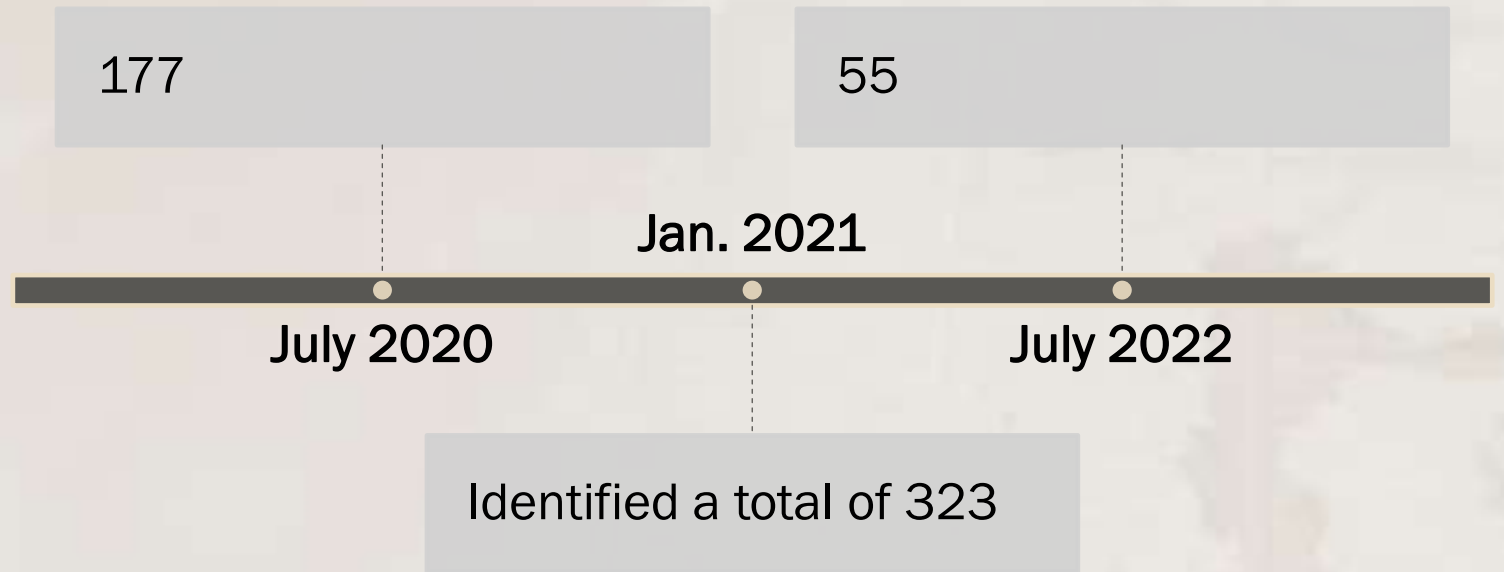

DIRECTIVE GENERAL ORDER SIGHT CHECKS – DETENTION STAFF

- Sight checks will be conducted in accordance with applicable policy and Oklahoma Jail Standards and at the appropriate intervals for the unit supervised.
- Beginning and ending of sight checks for each location will be communicated to Camera Operations via radio.
- Any delays in timeliness of sight checks will be communicated and assistance from any available, trained Personnel will be requested via radio.
- Sight checks will continue to be documented in logbooks as previously directed.



HEALTH DEPARTMENT

FACILITY SECURITY CAMERA SYSTEM

- Camera Project – Begins July 6, will take 1 month
 - Installing 210 digital cameras – going to all-digital in facility
 - Covid contact tracing – system can follow someone throughout the facility using facial recognition
 - Longer archive storage life
 - Replaced data server cooler system (old cooler original to facility)

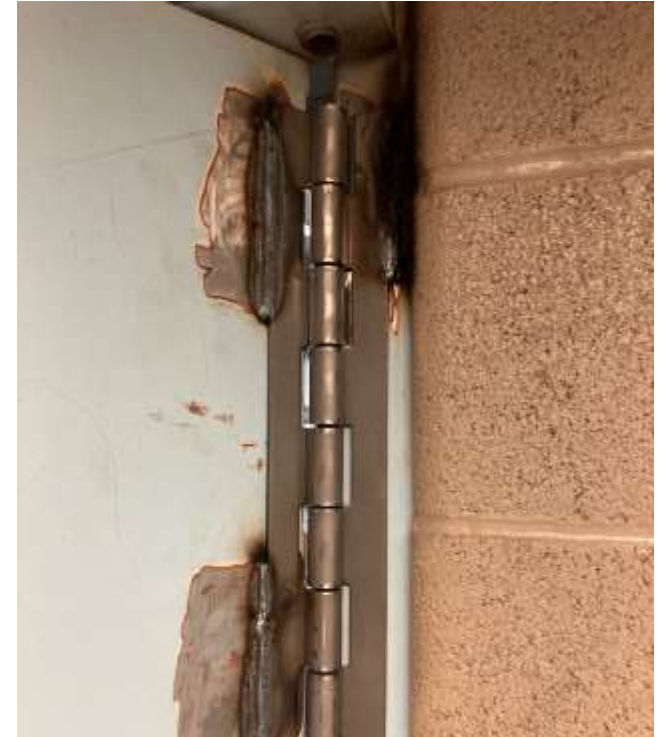
